Why is coffee pricing going up?

Many people are wondering why coffee prices have skyrocketed recently. The answer is both simple and complex - simple in that there's a case of supply and demand; complex in that there are many factors affecting the price.

Prices for coffee have more than doubled over the past year, driven by such diverse forces as climate change, and coffee drinkers truthfully have just increased world wide.

World coffee supplies are dwindling. When coffee prices dropped below the cost of producing it, many farmers pulled up their plants to grow more lucrative crops or sold their land to developers. And since a coffee plant takes five years to begin producing cherries; even with the higher prices it will take years for production to catch up with demand. Combine this with adverse weather patterns in the coffee producing regions of the world (drought in East Africa, excessive and ill-timed rains in Central and South America and a fungal infestation in Colombia), along with a middle class in India and China turning increasingly to coffee, and you have a "perfect storm" to cause prices to rise. Add in speculators, fund managers and other traders (coffee is the second most traded commodity in the world after oil) and there is even more upward pressure.
